Gunther to Honor Music Director

JEFFERSONVILLE – **NYS Assembly Member Aileen Gunther** (D-Forestburgh) will pay tribute to the Weekend of Chamber Music and artistic director Judith Pearce at **2 pm on July 9**, opening day of the Pearce's *Summer Festival 2006 – In the Company of Mozart*. Gunther will speak and present a Resolution on the **Main Street** (Route 52) lawn between the Presbyterian Church and the Post Office.

Gunther is coming to recognize WCM's contribution to the cultural and educational life of the county through its 13-year history. Under the direction of founder and flutist Pearce, the organization provides professional caliber chamber music concerts open to the public, and original educational programming for children in Sullivan County. Internationally acclaimed musicians travel to the area every year to take part in WCM's mission to provide opportunities for people of all ages to experience the intimacy and warmth of live chamber music.

Mozart resurrected will be on hand with treats for children, and the **WCM musicians will perform** a free all-Mozart concert immediately after the Assemblywoman's talk. A Meet-the-Artists' Reception at the Blue Victorian, a wine tasting at Mullally's and other special events in town follow the concert. All are welcome. The summer festival runs **through July 22** at the Eddie Adams Farm and other locations near Jeffersonville.
