MHS GRAD RECEIVES SCHOLARSHIP
– DATE CHANGE –

LAKE HUNTINGTON – Judith Pearce, artistic director of the Weekend of Chamber Music, announces that the 2007 Steven Rovitz Chamber Music Scholarship will be given to Tanisha Gray who graduated from Monticello High School this year.

Tanisha was a four-year participant in MHS's chamber music program, directed by Ann Trombley, and a regular participant in the WCM Artist Coaching Project at the school. Tanisha is a violinist and was a member of the student quartet, The Funky Shoes.

The \$500 scholarship is given annually to a deserving student who plans to continue with music after high school. It was established in 2004 in honor of Monticello music teacher Steven Rovitz, one of the chamber music program's founders, after he retired from the district with 33 years of service.

Judith Pearce will present the award to Tanisha at **8 pm on July 14** during the *Beethoven, Schubert & the Americans* Summer Music Festival at the Eddie Adams Farm in Jeffersonville.
